

LETTER FROM THE CHAIR

Our founder, William W. Allen, had a clear vision of a world where everyone would have nutritious meals daily. In 2024, Allen trustees evaluated 453 grant requests. 46 were funded. Grants were awarded in three categories; 1. Hunger Programs, 2. Nutrition Education and 3. Nutrition Research. A number of exciting programs awarded grants included: a pilot project that focuses on educating members of minority communities to become Health Educators who would then develop and operationalize culturally tailored nutrition programs; a farm-based feeding program that plans the amount of fresh produce it will produce and distributes it to feeding centers in the area; and a research program to evaluate and increase the nutritional content in meals served at senior centers.

The Allen family wishes to express its gratitude to William Lauderbach for his 36 years of excellent service as treasurer, upon his much-deserved retirement from the Allen Foundation. He generously donated significant expertise and time over many years to the foundation. We wish him the best in the future.

This year, we welcomed a new trustee, Maclain McAllister. He is the great-grandson of our founder and is currently attending Michigan State University. He will graduate from MSU with a BS in May 2025.

I am grateful for the outstanding efforts of our Allen Foundation trustees and staff. It is only because of their strong commitment to the mission of the Allen Foundation that the foundation is able to foster exciting positive change in the field of human nutrition.

GRANT APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The Allen Foundation Inc. operates under the laws of the State of Michigan, with offices in Midland. In order to be considered for an Allen Foundation grant, you must be a non-profit organization, and be able to provide us with a copy of your federal Internal Revenue Service certification of 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status. Academic research under an Allen Foundation grant should be conducted under the leadership of a principal investigator who is a full-time regular faculty member with tenure or on tenure track. The foundation does not directly administer the programs which it funds. Recipients are asked to submit yearly progress reports and a financial accounting concerning the expenditures of the foundation grant.

Grants are strictly limited under the terms of the charter to projects that benefit programs for human nutrition in the areas of health, education, training, and research. The foundation requires electronic submission of all unsolicited applications for consideration for possible funding. Please go to: https://www. allenfoundation.org and follow the instructions for filing a grant application online. Grant application deadlines are January 15 and July 15 of each calendar year. This means that any proposal submitted electronically after the deadlines will be considered for possible funding during the next application cycle. The decisions of the board of trustees will be posted on the foundation's website in May and November of each year. Because of the number of proposals received and the limited resources of the foundation, applicants should never view possible declinations to fund their proposals or delays in reviewing their proposals as judgments on the actual merits of their proposals.
